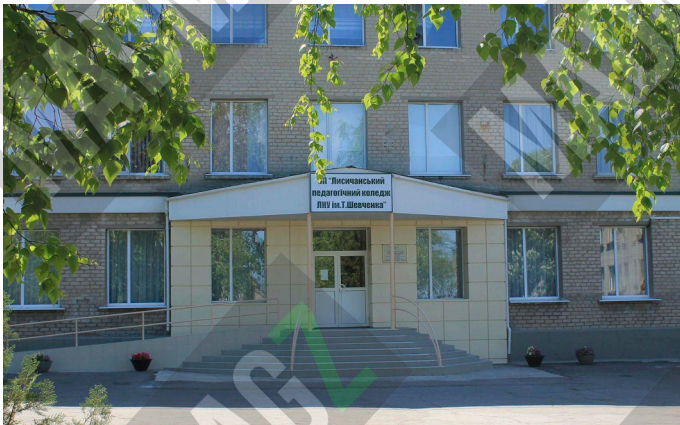

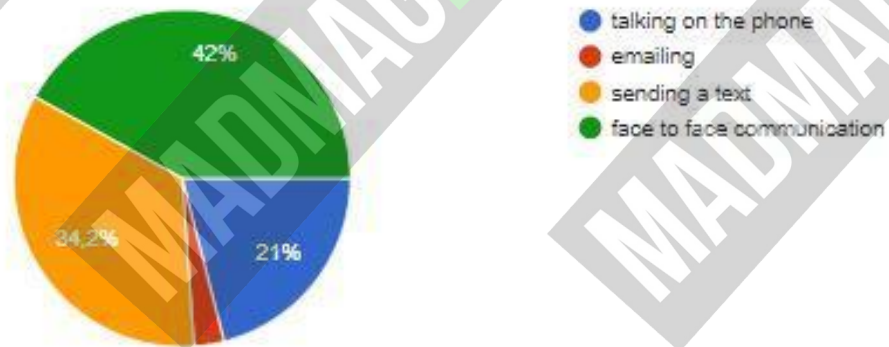

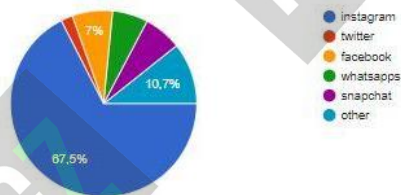
1. How do you most like to communicate with others? (Greece, Arsakeia)

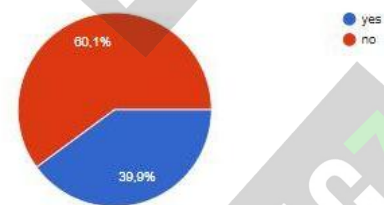
2. What social media do you prefer? (France/Croatia)

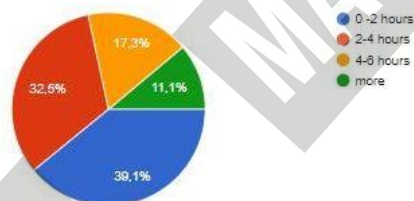
6. Do you use your computer on a daily basis? (Slovakia)

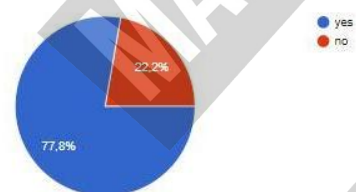
7. How many hours a day are you online? (Turkey)

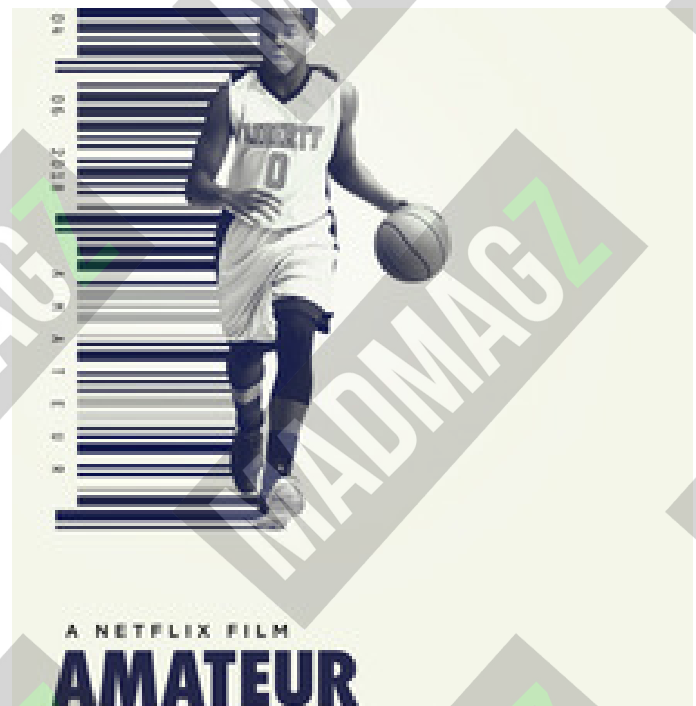
▲ HOME ALONE

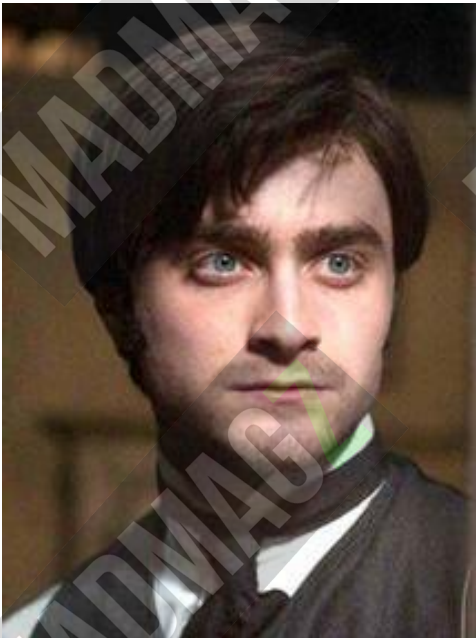
DR STRANGE ▶

A real interview to an expert in Book Bindery that has visited our school by Katerina K. (English class, 4th Junior High School of Petroupolis, Greece)

It was just an ordinary day at school when I learnt that a book binder, Mr Nikas Nikolaos, would be visiting our school and we could have the opportunity to watch the process of book binding. As I watched him binding, I found this really interesting and it was at the moment that I decided that I would like to interview Mr Nikas and learn more about this ancient craft.

I would like to express my gratitude to Mr. Nikas for the kindness he showed and the knowledge he shared with us today. And here is the interview:

-When did you first get in touch with this craft?

-It was back in 2002 when I decided to learn some things about it so i attended seminars in the Hellenic American Union by a renowned bookbinder Mr. Karampetsos. -ies as well as in Greece.

-And when did you come up with the idea to be engaged professionally with bookbinding?

-The truth is that i have been an amateur bookbinder for 15 years. I have always wanted to deal with artistic bookbinding as i have been keen on visual arts. After i had learned the craft, i tried applying all the other visual arts to it such as drawing, sculpture, engraving etc. This was a challenging process which gave me the opportunity to take part in international bookbinding competitions in many countries as well as in Greece.

-As i was watching you bind the books i was wondering which part of the process you find the most interesting

-Having been a visual artist for over 40 years i have to admit that my favorite part is decorating books... so artistic bookbinding is the most interesting and challenging part of my work.

-Which of the books you have created so far is your favorite?

-To tell the truth, i love all my works of art -all of them are unique and are of the same emotional value to me. **-How can anyone, who is interesting in bookbinding, learn the craft?**

-Unfortunately, nowadays there are not any bookbinding schools in Greece but people have the ability to attend seminars and workshops, organised by several colleges all over Greece.

I would also like to note that bookbinding is neither too difficult nor too demanding, All it takes is to become a professional bookbinder is love about book and dedication.



WHAT IS BOOK BINDING ?

Book binding, also known as book bindery, is the process of assembling and securing written or printed pages with a cover.

In most cases the cover is thicker than the interior pages of the book to provide durability to the finished book. Books have been part of the world since the early ages and so the need to bind them together has also been present since then. Book binding probably originated in India, where religious sutras were copied on to palm trees.

However the craft of book binding is an ancient Greek craft which became popular to the West during Renaissance, when aristocrats wished to have big libraries and for that reason they employed Greek bookbinders from Byzantium.

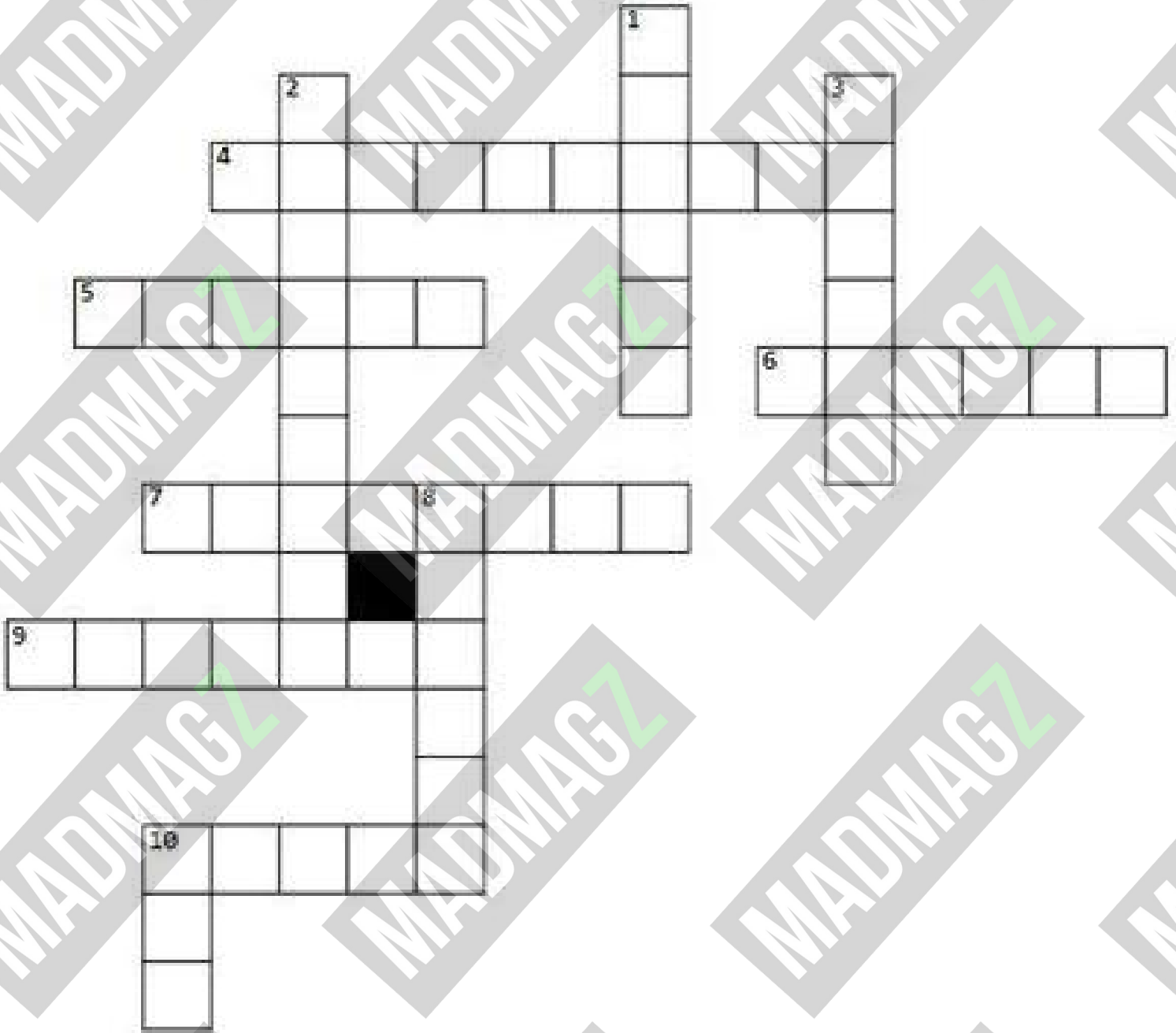
